Euston is a London Underground station served by the Victoria line and both branches of the Northern line. It directly connects with Euston main line station above it. Euston railway station (/ ˈjuːstən /; also known as London Euston) is a central London railway terminus on Euston Road in the London Borough of Camden, managed by Network Rail. Euston Railway Station information - Regular train services depart Euston for destinations in the Midlands, the Northwest and Scotland. The original Euston station opened in 1837 and was the first intercity station to be built in London, so there was much controversy in the 1960s when the original building was demolished to coincide with the electrification of the West Coast Main Line., Euston Station Through Time.
