A mental disorder, also called a mental illness or psychiatric disorder, is a behavioral or mental pattern that causes significant distress or impairment of personal functioning. Such features may be persistent, relapsing and remitting, or occur as a single episode. The Inpatient Unit has both general and observation wards and offers supervised care in hospital when community treatment is not possible. Individuals are admitted to the observation ward when they have a mental illness or disorder that needs to be treated to stabilise their mental state.
