Best all round, those are my recommendations. If Aperture and Bokeh are your main concerns, I would go with the Sigma 30mm 1.4. It is also a great substitute for the Canon 35mm 1.4 L \$1370 and it really reminded me of that lens. Archaeological excavations in parts of Kathmandu have found evidence of ancient civilisations. The oldest of these findings is a statue, found in Maligaon, that was dated at 185 AD. The excavation of Dhando Chaitya uncovered a brick with an inscription in Brahmi script.
